- AMOUNT: \$1,000 PER AWARD
- AWARDED TO: RPCI PRESENT OR CONTRACTED EMPLOYEE PURSUING FIRST DEGREE.

### CRITERIA:

- RPCI PRESENT OR CONTRACTED EMPLOYEE IN GOOD STANDING WITH ONE OR MORE YEARS OF SERVICE AT RPCI.
- RPCI PRESENT OR CONTRACTED EMPLOYEE PURSUING A DEGREE IN A HEALTH-RELATED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM AT AN ACCREDITED LOCAL COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY.



## EVA M. NOLES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



THE FIRST AFRICAN-AMERICAN WOMAN TO TRAIN AND GRADUATE AS A REGISTERED NURSE IN BUFFALO, NEW YORK, WHO WENT ON TO BECOME A NURSING EDUCATOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF NURSING AT THE WORLD-RENOWNED ROSWELL PARK CANCER INSTITUTE.

## EVA M. NOLES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

ROSWELL PARK CANCER INSTITUTE (RPCI) HAS DEVELOPED THE EVA M. NOLES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM TO OFFER ASSISTANCE EDUCATION-RELATED EXPENSES TO ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS WHO WISH TO PURSUE A CAREER IN HEALTHCARE.

IN 2008, THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM WAS CREATED TO RECOGNIZE THE EXTRAORDINARY EFFORTS PUT FORTH BY EVA M. NOLES IN SUPPORT OF CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY HER TO RPCI OVER THIRTY YEARS AND TO HER LIFE-LONG CONTRIBUTIONS TO COMMUNITIES THROUGHOUT THE WESTERN NEW YORK-REGION.

### DESCRIPTION

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS WILL RECEIVE A PREDETERMINED AMOUNT OF FUNDING FROM RPCI THAT WOULD BE APPLIED TOWARDS ONE SEMESTER'S COLLEGE-RELATED EXPENSES. THE PROGRAM REQUIRES THE CANDIDATE TO BE A PRESENT OR CONTRACTED EMPLOYEE OF RPCI WHO WORKS A MINIMUM OF 37.5 HOURS EACH WEEK WHILE MAINTAINING AT LEAST ONE-HALF STATUS IN AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM.



## EVA M. NOLES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

### PROCESS

CANDIDATE SELECTION IS BASED UPON (1) ANSWERS TO AN ESSAY QUESTION; (2) TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION FROM INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE KNOWLEDGEABLE OF THE APPLICANT'S CHARACTER, MOTIVATION AND WORK ETHIC; (3) AND, AN INTERVIEW WITH SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE MEMBERS.

SELECTED CANDIDATES MAY BE PROVIDED WITH A FLEXIBLE WORK SCHEDULE SO AS TO BEST MATCH HIS OR HER INDIVIDUAL NEEDS WITH THOSE OF RPCI.

### REQUIREMENTS

THE CANDIDATE WILL BE REQUIRED TO DO THE FOLLOWING:

- PROVIDE PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE TO AN ACCREDITED LOCAL COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY.
- WORK AT RPCI A MINIMUM OF 37.5 HOURS PER WEEK.
- SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS MUST MAINTAIN EMPLOYMENT AT RPCI FOR ONE FULL CALENDAR YEAR.
- MAINTAIN AT LEAST ONE-HALF STATUS IN A HEALTH-RELATED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM.
- REPAY ALL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM COSTS IN THE EVENT THE CANDIDATE DOES NOT COMPLETE HIS OR HER EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM IN A HEALTH-RELATED DISCIPLINE.
- UPON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE HEALTH-RELATED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM, THE CANDIDATE WILL HAVE HIS OR HER PREFERENCE FOR POSITIONS HE OR SHE ARE QUALIFIED FOR.
